It is time to register for the 2025-2026 school year.

**EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES:**

- 4K: Monday – Thursday 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.
- 5K – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade: Monday – Friday 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.
- 7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade: Monday – Friday 7:45 A.M. to 3:05 P.M.

Peace Lutheran School’s registration for the 2025-2026 school year will **open on January 17, 2025 at 8:00 A.M using the registration timetable below.**

- All students must complete a registration application each year to be enrolled.
- Registration is based on a “first come, first serve” basis. Once a class is full, a waiting list will be started based on the time and date the registration application was received.
- Once your application has been reviewed you will be sent an email with the next steps, whether that be any additional information, status of application, the book & technology fee, or the Choice Registration links.

**REGISTRATION TIMETABLE:**

- **January 17<sup>th</sup>** – Registration opens at 8:00 A.M. for Current Peace Lutheran Church Members with currently enrolled students in the School or Childcare.
- **January 24<sup>th</sup>** – Registration opens at 8:00 A.M. for Currently enrolled students in the School or Childcare, and Peace Lutheran Church Members without a current student.
- **February 7<sup>th</sup>** – Registration opens for Community Members.

**NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE:**

- **Current student’s families** will be notified via email of their acceptance upon the verification of their application
- **New student’s families** will be notified via mail of enrollment status by July 1st (date dependent on DPI selection process for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program).
- **ALL 4K Students** are classified as new students at Peace Lutheran School as that is the starting grade for Peace Lutheran School.

**CONDITIONS OF RE-ENROLLMENT:**

Current Peace students are eligible for re-enrollment upon review of the child’s school record including, but not limited to academic performance, conduct, and special needs. As well as payment of any outstanding fees, tuition and paid book & technology fee.



### **PEACE TUITION ASSISTANT GRANTS**

Peace Tuition Assistant Grants are available to those families in need. An application form can be picked up at the office and must be turned in no later than June 30, 2025. If you are awarded a PLM grant, you will be required to enroll in an automated monthly payment process.
